Enter this mysterious world and see rock layers that began forming 250 million years ago. Enjoy a breathtaking sight of a wide variety of flowers in a huge greenhouse and the well-groomed outdoor gardens at the Hamamatsu Flower Park. Many of the stations are 10 to 15 meters above ground. Equipped with a harness and attached to a safety line, participants cross unique obstacles from tree to tree. It's safe and requires no prior training other than a 15 minute introductory session upon arrival. This tour is restricted to those 10 years and older and at least 140cm / 56 inches tall. Maximum allowable weight: 130kg / 285lbs
IMPOTANT: Athletic shoes required. Children must be accompanied by an adult during the course, and no more than two children per adult. Admission is included.

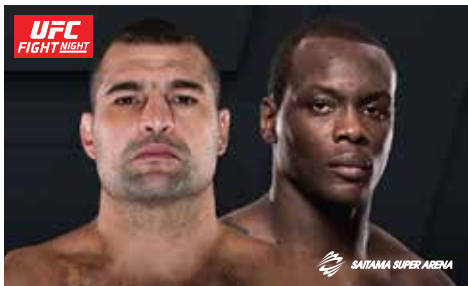
