

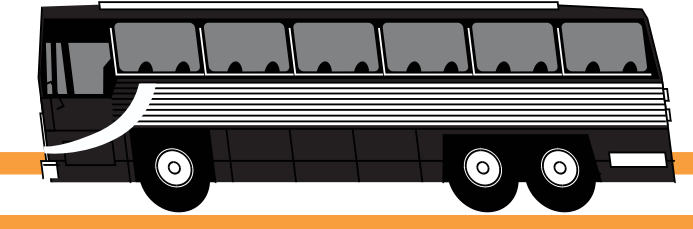

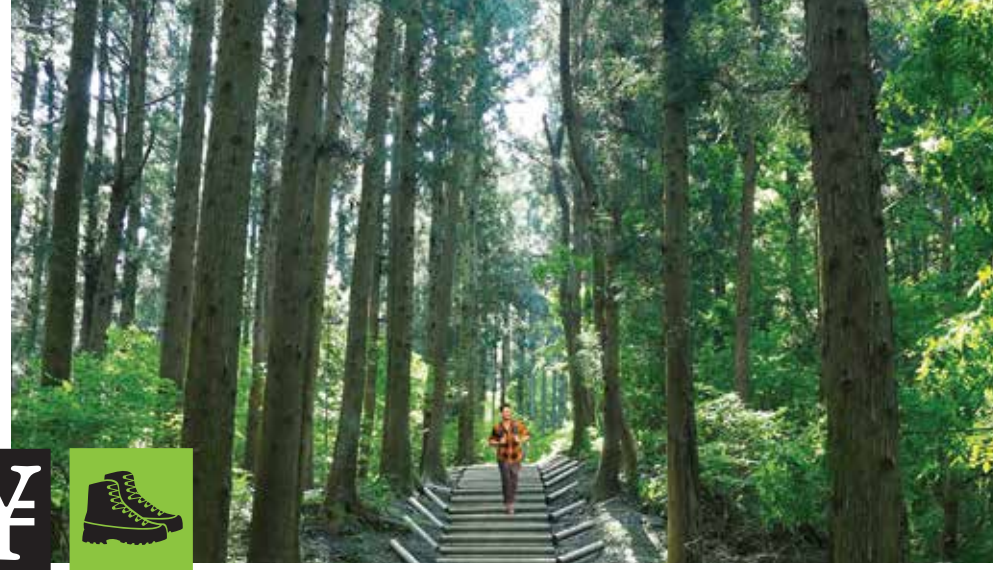

NAF ATSUGI MWR ITT HIKING CLASSIFICATION

- EASY/BEGINNER:** Trails are 80% flat and 20% ascending and descending. Total distance: About 6 miles.
- INTERMEDIATE:** Trails are 50% uphill and downhill, and 50% flat, with a variety of terrain. Ascending these trails are moderately physically demanding and descending them is moderately demanding on lower body muscles and joints. Total distance is 6 to 10 miles.
- Advanced:** Trails are 90% up and down hill with rugged and slippery terrain, with a total distance of 6 to 10 miles. Mt. Fuji falls in this category due to its high elevation.
