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

This signature British-style red brick chimney that you see afar on the hill of the northern side of White Beach is one of three chimneys of an old sugar mill. This sugar mill was built in 1940 and used to be looking down all the sugarcane farms in the area from above. Those bullet holes from the Battle of Okinawa are still visible. Now it is preserved for the future generations as one of the most important historical sites of Heshikiya peninsula.

"Waitu" means "taken from a split rock. In the past, villagers had to climb up and down steep mountain paths, but now they have carved out 150m of rock using only hand tools such as hoes and completed the farm road "Wai tui". It took three years from 1932 to complete.

It is now registered as a cultural asset of Uruma City. Team work DOES make the dream work!
